

TRANSANTARCTIC SUPRAMICRONATIONAL ALLIANCE TREATY



The Parties to this Treaty reaffirm their desire to live in peace with all peoples and all governments. They are determined to safeguard the freedom, common heritage and civilization of their peoples, founded on the principles of democracy, individual liberty and the rule of law. They seek to promote stability and well-being in the Antarctic area. They are resolved to unite their efforts for collective defense and for the preservation of peace and security. They therefore agree to this Transantarctic Supramicronational Alliance Treaty:

Article 1

The Parties undertake to settle any international dispute in which they may be involved by peaceful means in such a manner that international peace and security and justice are not endangered, and to refrain in their international relations from the threat or use of force in any manner, unless there is a high level of threat to the national security of a Party proclaimed by a state of emergency.

Article 2

The Parties will contribute toward the further development of peaceful and friendly international relations by strengthening their free institutions, by bringing about a better understanding of the principles upon which these institutions are founded, and by promoting conditions of stability and well-being. They will seek to eliminate conflict in their international economic policies and will encourage economic collaboration between any or all of them.

Article 3

For effective achievement of the objectives of this Treaty, the Parties, separately and jointly, by means of continuous and effective self-help and mutual aid, will maintain and develop their individual and collective capacity to resist attacks.

Article 4

The Parties will consult together whenever, in the opinion of any of them, the territorial integrity, political independence or security of any of the Parties is threatened.

Article 5

The Parties hereby establish the TSA Council, on which each of them shall be represented, to consider matters concerning the implementation of this Treaty. The Council shall be managed by a President, which is to be elected yearly with Party representatives being both candidates and voters. Each Party is allowed only one vote. The Council shall set up such subsidiary bodies as may be necessary; in particular, it shall establish immediately a defense committee, which shall recommend measures for the implementation of Articles 3 and 6.

Article 6

The Parties agree that an attack against one or more of them in Antarctica or representative territories across the ocean shall be considered an attack against them all and consequently they agree that, if such an attack occurs, each of them, in exercise of the right of individual or collective self-defense, will assist the Party or Parties attacked by taking forthwith, individually and in concert with the other Parties, such action as it deems necessary to restore and maintain the security of the Antarctic area.

Any such attack and all measures taken as a result thereof shall immediately be reported to the Council. Such measures shall be terminated when the Council has taken the measures necessary to restore and maintain international peace and security.

Article 7

This Treaty does not affect, and shall not be interpreted as affecting in any way the rights and obligations under the Charter of the Parties which are members of the Antarctic Micronational Union.

Article 8

Each Party declares that none of the international engagements now in force between it and any other of the Parties or any third State is in conflict with the provisions of this Treaty, and undertakes not to enter into any international engagement in conflict with this Treaty.

Article 9

The Parties may, by unanimous agreement, invite any other Antarctic micronation in a position to further the principles of this Treaty and to contribute to the security of the Antarctic area to accede to this Treaty. Any State so invited may become a Party to the Treaty by depositing its instrument of accession with the Government of the United Republics of Antarctica. The Government of the United Republics of Antarctica will inform each of the Parties of the deposit of each such instrument of accession.

Article 10

This Treaty shall be ratified and its provisions carried out by the Parties in accordance with their respective constitutional processes. The instruments of ratification shall be deposited as soon as possible with the Government of the United Republics of Antarctica, which will notify all the other signatories of each deposit. The Treaty shall enter into force between the States, which have ratified it as soon as the ratifications of the majority of the signatories have been deposited and shall come into effect with respect to other States on the date of the deposit of their ratifications.

Article 11

After the Treaty has been in force for a year, or at any time thereafter, the Parties shall, if any of them so requests, consult together for the purpose of reviewing the Treaty, having regard for the factors then affecting peace and security in the Antarctic area, including the development of universal as well as regional arrangements for the maintenance of international peace and security.

Article 12

After the Treaty has been in force for one year, any Party may cease to be a Party three months after its notice of denunciation has been given to the Government of the United Republics of Antarctica, which will inform the Governments of the other Parties of the deposit of each notice of denunciation.

Article 13

This Treaty shall be deposited in the archives of the Government of the United Republics of Antarctica. Duly certified copies will be transmitted by that Government to the Governments of other signatories.


